- 2. Such Environmental Clearance shall be obtained from the Central Government or the State Level Environment Impact Assessment Authority (SEIAA), duly constituted under sub-section (3) of Section 3 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- The project Proponents/stakelholders are advised to engage QCI-NABET (Quality Council of India-National Accreditation Board for Education and Training) accredited consultants for the preparations of EIA/EMP Reports and environmental clearances processes.

This advisory is issued for the awareness of the General Public and all prospective Project Proponents (including Private Firms, Government Agencies, Societies, etc.), to comply the requirement of obtaining prior Environmental Clearance for all projects or activities listed in the Schedule appended herewith.
