**TRAFFIC MOVEMENT RESTRICTION ORDER (U/S 159(2) OF SIKKIM  
POLICE ACT 2008)**

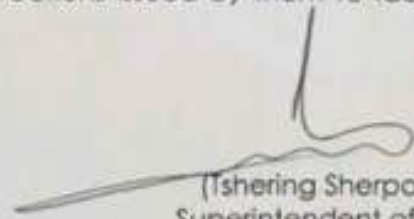
WHEREAS, the 9th Jan Mukti Diwas-cum-2nd Aama Diwas is scheduled to be celebrated at Goli Ground, Rangpo, on 10.08.2026, and a large number of members of the public and beneficiaries from across the State are expected to attend the programme in numerous vehicles;

AND WHEREAS, it is considered necessary to regulate vehicular traffic to ensure the smooth flow of traffic, maintain public safety, and minimise inconvenience to the general public;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Tshering Sherpa, SPS, Superintendent of Police, Pakyong District, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me under Section 159(2) of the Sikkim Police Act, 2008, do hereby order the following traffic regulations, which shall remain in force on 10.08.2026:

1. The movement of all heavy vehicles shall remain prohibited on the Singtam-Rangpo and Rangpo-Rorathang-Pakyong routes, and vice versa, from 0500 hours to 2100 hours.
2. All categories of light vehicles proceeding from Singtam, Gangtok, and Ranipool towards Siliguri shall be diverted via Ranipool-Pakyong-Rorathang-Kumrek-Rangpo, with one way regulation.
3. All categories of light vehicles proceeding from the Singtam side to attend the 9th Jan Mukti Diwas-cum-2nd Aama Diwas shall be diverted via the Singtam-Duga-Rangpo Road, with one way regulation.
4. All categories of light vehicles proceeding from the Siliguri side towards Singtam shall be diverted via Rangpo-Mining-Samurdung-Adarsh Gaon-Singtam Road, with one way regulation.
5. Emergency vehicles, including ambulances, fire tenders, Police vehicles, and other vehicles engaged in essential services, shall be exempted from these restrictions and diversions.
6. All motorists are requested to cooperate with the Police and Traffic personnel on duty and strictly comply with the directions issued by them to facilitate the smooth conduct of the event.
