Terms of Reference

The Task Force shall:

1. Coordinate with the concerned authorities of the Government of India, Embassy of India in Kathmandu, Government of Nepal and other relevant agencies for obtaining verified information regarding Sikkim residents affected by the flash floods.
2. Collect, compile and verify information regarding persons reported missing, stranded, injured, deceased or otherwise affected in the incident.
3. Establish communication with the families of affected Sikkim residents and facilitate the exchange of verified information regarding their status and whereabouts.
4. Coordinate with the concerned District Administrations, Police authorities and other Departments/Agencies of the State Government for verification and necessary assistance.
5. Facilitate, wherever required, necessary relief, medical assistance, transportation and other support to affected persons and their families, in accordance with applicable rules and directions of the Competent Authority.
6. Maintain a consolidated database/status report of affected Sikkim residents and submit regular updates to the Competent Authority.

7. Undertake any other related activity as may be assigned by the Competent Authority in connection with the relief and assistance operations.

The Task Force shall remain functional until further orders and may co-opt representatives from other Departments/Agencies as and when considered necessary for effective discharge of its functions.

This issues with the approval of the Competent Authority.
