## NOTICE FOR FILLING UP VACANT POSITION OF MEMBER OF JUVENILE JUSTICE BOARD (JJB)

Applications are invited from eligible local candidates for filling up the post of Member, JJB on contractual basis for a period of three years under Child Protection Scheme in the Women and Child Development Department sponsored by the Ministry of Women & Child Development. The details of post and eligibility criteria are as under:

## **TERMS AND CONDITIONS:**

- 1. These posts do not carry any pay scale or salary.
- 2. The tenure of the post is for a period of 03 years.
- 3. The appointment shall not confer any rights for regularization in the future.
- 4. The member shall be selected through walk-in-interview of the eligible applicants.
- 5. Only candidates fulfilling the above eligibility criteria as prescribed against the post shall apply.
- 6. Candidates must be in good health and physically fit to discharge his/her duties.
- 7. Applicants for the post of Member of JJB should not be less than 27 (twenty seven) years of age at the time of submission of application or on the last date of submission of application(s).
- 8. Preference will be given to retired Government Officers having the required qualification(s).
- 9. As prescribed by the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015/Rules. The JJB Members are required to sit on all working days unless the case pendency is less.

10. No members shall be selected if he/she

- (i) is associated with any Child Care Institution, directly or indirectly, during his tenure as a member of the board or committee or have any conflict of interest.
- (ii) has been involved in any immoral act or in act of child abuse. NOC from concerned thana required.

Applicants along with the resume addressed to the Special Secretary-cum-Director, CPS, W&CDD, with the following valid documents, email id and contact number must be submitted to the office of Deputy Secretary, CPS, Women and Child Development Department, Lumsey, East Sikkim on or before 31/05/2022 latest by 4.00 pm. Only those applicants with prescribed and properly attested documents received within the stipulated date and time shall be entertained.

- 5. Experience Certificate duly certified by the relevant Issuing Authority.
