NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the State Government has deemed it expedient to fill up 50 (fifty) posts of Accounts Officer under the Sikkim Finance and Accounts Service;

And whereas, the method of recruitment to the post of Accounts Officer as prescribed under rule 6 read with the Schedule-II of Sikkim Finance and Accounts Service Rules, 1978 is 50% by direct recruitment through open competitive examination and 50% by promotion through limited departmental competitive examination/ deputation / re-employment;

And whereas the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary and expedient to relax the provision relating to the method of recruitment prescribed under rule 6 read with Schedule-II of the said rules to promote 50 (fifty) Senior Accountant to the post of Accounts Officer duly relaxing the provision of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination/deputation/ re-employment and utilizing 50% direct recruitment quota of Accounts Officer;

And whereas, rule 28 of the said rules provide for relaxation of the provision of the rules;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by rule 28 of the Sikkim Finance and Accounts Service Rules, 1978, the State Government is hereby pleased to relax the provision relating to method of recruitment prescribed under rule 6 read with Schedule-II of the said rules with a view to promote 50 (fifty) Senior Accountant to the post of Accounts Officer on substantive capacity duly relaxing the provision of Limited Departmental Competitive Examination/deputation/re-employment and utilizing 27 (twenty-seven) posts of direct recruitment quota of Accounts Officer as one-time relaxation through Sikkim Public Service Commission.
