### **NOTIFICATION**

Whereas the State Government has deemed it expedient to fill up the post of Upper Division Clerks and equivalent in the Sikkim Sub-ordinate (Ministerial and Executive) Service Rules, 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the said rules) by way of promotion on seniority-cum-merit basis;

And whereas under rule 7 read with Schedule-II of the Sikkim Sub-ordinate (Ministerial and Executive) Service Rules, 1984, the method of recruitment to the post of Upper Division Clerks and equivalent is 50% by direct recruitment through open competitive examination and 50% by promotion through Limited Departmental competitive examination;

And whereas there are large number of Lower Division Clerks who have already completed more than 27 years of service in the same post and have gained a considerable experience and knowledge;

And whereas the State Government is of the opinion that it is necessary and expedient to relax the provision relating to the method of recruitment prescribed under rule 7 read with Schedule-II, under item Grade-III of the said rules to promote the Lower Division Clerks and equivalent to the post of Upper Division Clerks on seniority-cum-merit basis;

And whereas rule 10 of the said rules provide for relaxation the method of recruitment:

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by rule 10 of the Sikkim Sub-Ordinate (Ministerial and Executive) Service Rules, 1984, the Governor of Sikkim is hereby pleased to relax the provision of the method of recruitment prescribed under rule 7 read with Schedule-II, under item Grade-III of the said rules with a view to promote on officiating capacity the Lower Division Clerks and equivalent to the post of Upper Division Clerks on seniority-cum-merit basis as one time relaxation.
