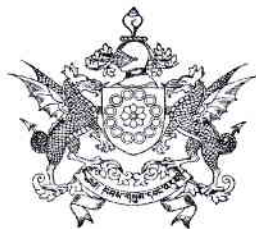

THE SIKKIM APPROPRIATION ACT, 2023

(ACT NO. 01 OF 2023)

AN

ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Sikkim for the services for the part of the Financial Year 2022-23.

BE it enacted by the Legislature of Sikkim in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows: -

| Short title | 1. This Act may be called the Sikkim Appropriation Act, 2023. |
| Issue of 965,49,42,000/- out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Sikkim for the Financial Year 2022-23 | 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Sikkim, there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in column 5 of the Schedule amounting in aggregate to the sum of Rupees nine hundred sixty five crore forty nine lakh forty two thousand only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course for payment during the Financial Year 2022-23, in respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of the Schedule. |
| Appropriation | 3. The sum authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Sikkim by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule in relation to the said year. |
