The following Act passed by the Sikkim Legislative Assembly and having received the assent of the Governor on 18<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2023 is hereby published for general information:-

#### THE SIKKIM APPROPRIATION ACT, 2023

(ACT NO. 01 OF 2023)

#### AN

#### ACT

to authorise payment and appropriation of certain further sums from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Sikkim for the services for the part of the Financial Year 2022-23.

**BE** it enacted by the Legislature of Sikkim in the Seventy-fourth Year of the Republic of India as follows: -

**Short title 1.** This Act may be called the Sikkim Appropriation Act, 2023.

issue of 2. From and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Sikkim, there 965,49,42,000/may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified in out of the column 5 of the Schedule amounting in aggregate to the sum of Consolidated Rupees nine hundred sixty five crore forty nine lakh forty two Fund of the State thousand only towards defraying the several charges which will of Sikkim for the come in course for payment during the Financial Year 2022-23, in **Financial Year** respect of the services and purposes specified in column 2 of the 2022-23 Schedule.

Appropriation3. The sum authorised to be paid and applied from and out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Sikkim by this Act shall be appropriated for the services and purposes specified in the Schedule in relation to the said year.
